- 5. On September 27, 2022, Petitioner Timothy Kirkwood filed an administrative complaint with the Colorado Secretary of State. A copy of the administrative complaint is attached as Exhibit 3 to the Second Amended Verified Petition.
- 6. Petitioners aver that the Second Amended Verified Petition, attached hereto as Exhibit A, together with Exhibits 1, 1.1, 2, and 3 that are incorporated therein by reference, sufficiently states a claim for relief.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners respectfully ask the Court to grant leave to amend the verified petition, and to enter an order approving the filing of the Second Amended Verified Petition attached hereto as Exhibit A.
