RE: Your Unauthorized use of the Republican Party Name

Dear Ms. Cage & Mr. Mack:

I represent the Colorado Republican Committee ("CRC"). Section 1-3-108 of the Colorado Revised Statutes provides that "no person, group of persons or organization shall use the name or address of a political party, in any manner, unless the person, group of persons, or organization has received permission to use the name or address from the executive committee of the political party." Article XVII of the Bylaws of the Republican State Central Committee provides a process by which individuals or organizations may apply to use the party name.

To date, neither of you nor your MyColoradoGOP organization have applied to use of the party name. Hence, your use of the Colorado GOP name in your communications – to include your website, your URL, your emails, and the name of your organization – is in violation of state law and the CRC Bylaws.

The CRC hereby demands that you cease and desist from using the name "Colorado GOP" to identify yourself or your organization in your website, your URL, your emails, and the name of your organization in any form unless and until you receive permission to do so from the CRC, per Article XVII of the CRC Bylaws.
