

Overview of County Republican Party Organization

Organization

- Central Committee
- Executive Committee
- Chairman can appoint a Treasurer, IEC Chairman, and/or other additional roles (as they see fit).
- Chairman can appoint members to Standing (i.e. Audit, Bylaws, Finance, etc.) and Special Committees (i.e. Credential, Rules, Resolutions, etc.)

Membership*

- Organization's Power Comes from its Central Committee.
 - Central Committee is mostly made up of Precinct Committee Persons (PCPs), also includes Officers, Elected Officials in the County, and District Captains.
 - Up to Two PCPs are allotted per precinct in the county.
 - Central Committee elects Officers every odd year between 01-14 Feb.
 - Officers Chosen are Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, at minimum.
 - Some counties have more than one Vice-Chairman.
- * As per approved County Party bylaws.
- Also Executive Committee, mostly made up of Officers, District Captains, House & Senate District Officers, and elected officials in the county.

Overview of County Republican Party Organization

Meetings

- Organizational Meeting 01-14 Feb ODD YEAR.
 - Elect Officers, District Captains, Bonus Members (to State GOP Central Committee and/or multi-county congressional & house districts).
 - Suspend Org. Meeting to Open House & Senate District Meetings to elect its officers.
- Central Committee Meeting – usually 1-2 meetings, at minimum, per year.
- Executive Committee Meeting – usually once a month.
- Special Meeting – Driven by the call (invite with purpose of the meeting).
- Meetings usually require a quorum which is a minimum amount of members for the specific meeting.
- Meetings are governed under the county party bylaws and Roberts Rules of Order (parliamentary procedure).

Overview of STATE Republican Party Organization

Organization

- State Central Committee (SCC).
- State Executive Committee (SEC).
- Chairman can appoint a Treasurer, IEC Chairman, and/or other additional roles (as they see fit).
- Chairman can appoint members to Standing (i.e. Audit, Bylaws, Finance, etc.) and Special Committees (i.e. Credential, Rules, Resolutions, etc.)

Membership

- Organization's Power Comes from its State Central Committee.
- Central Committee is mostly made up of State Officers, CO (State-Wide) Elected Officials, County Party Officers, and Bonus Members.
 - Bonus Members allotted based on last President/Governor race results
 - Some counties have more than one Vice-Chairman so the VC Vote of 1 at the SCC is split accordingly.

Meetings


- Organizational Meeting March – April of Odd Year
 - Elect Officers - Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, at minimum.
- State Central Committee Meeting – usually 1-2 meetings, at minimum, per year.
- State Executive Committee Meeting – usually once a month.
- Special Meeting – Driven by the call (invite with purpose of the meeting).
- Meetings usually require a quorum which is a minimum amount of members for the specific meeting.
- Meetings are governed under the State Party bylaws and Roberts Rules of Order (parliamentary procedure).

Precinct Strategy for Colorado Republicans

- 64 Counties
- Find Republicans in each county.
- Determine which counties are aligned, friendly with our US Constitution, Conservative Republican Platform, in addition to supporting Election Integrity, Strong Borders, etc.
- Friendly County - Have a Patriot Request their Bylaws and Central Committee List.
- Unfriendly County - Have a Patriot Request their Bylaws and Central Committee List.
- Find like minded republicans in open precincts (2 per precinct).
- Appoint them at a vacancy committee meeting (that's why we need the bylaws to re-confirm appointment)



How Do We Bring Conservative Leadership to your County and State Party

“Freedom Principles

1. Human Equality – All Men Are Created Equal
2. Natural Rights – Individuals Possess Equal Natural Rights
3. Government Secures Rights – Purpose of Government to Protect Individual Rights
4. Government by Consent – Legitimate Government Requires the Consent of the Governed
5. Limited Powers – Government of Limited Purpose Ought to be Limited in Power
6. Constitutional Government – A Written Constitution Limits the Power of Government
7. Rule of Law – Rule of Law Governs All
8. Equal Protection – Equal Protection for Equal Individual Rights
9. Limited Government Protects Privacy

Responsibilities of Citizenship

1. Self-Restraint – (Each) Citizen must first and foremost govern oneself.
2. Self-Assertion – Citizens must assert themselves in defense of their natural rights.
3. Civic Knowledge – Citizens must know the origin of their rights (from Creator God), identify the threats to their rights, and must infuse their civic knowledge throughout the larger culture.

Anil's Vision for Colorado Republicans

Vision - Enact "Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness (Property Rights)" at the local, state, and federal level of Government via the Republican Party and its candidates/elected officials.

1. Sue to overturn Open Primary and allow only Republicans to run their own caucuses/assemblies and pick their own candidates.

2. Sue to overturn or revise Amendment 27 so that black money is eliminated and true transparency will occur in all elections.

3. Sue to stop Mail-In Ballots and demand elections occur only on Election Day (and/or up to three days before as an early start) and ensure election integrity by removing "same day registration".

4. Vet all candidates in writing to get committal to the US Constitution and our Conservative Republican Platform.

5. Focus on winning school board and city government races.

6. Focus on building grassroots infrastructure.

7. Raise money and help counties raise money to win local, state, and federal races.

8. Sell my message to all voters especially those who are middle class and minority voters.

9. Hold all Republican elected officials publicly accountable to our principles highlighting CUT, POL, Heritage, Conservative Review, and other conservative group scores on votes.

10. Influence/Educate our children and colleges with our Constitution and our Conservative Republican Platform.

11. Do not charge people higher than at costs for caucuses/assemblies; I would not allow "pay for play".

12. Allow county parties to be fully self-sufficient (financial IEC, operations) and autonomous (from state party interference) to win all local elections.
